

FAR Flowdown Clauses June 20, 2023

The referenced clauses are set forth or referred to in the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and are incorporated by reference and shall predominate in the event of conflict with any other provision of the purchase order or agreement in which they are referenced (the "Purchase Order") unless specifically noted. To make these clauses applicable to this Purchase Order unless otherwise specified herein, "Government" shall mean Atlantic Diving Supply, Inc. ("ADS"), "Contractor" shall mean the entity (the "Seller") from which ADS is purchasing goods (the "Products") and/or services (the "Services"), "Contract" shall mean the Purchase Order, and "Contracting Officer" shall mean the ADS Purchasing Representative. The terms "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change (1) in the phrases "Government Property", "Government-Owned Property", "Government Equipment", "Government-Furnished Property", and "Government-Owned Equipment"; (2) when a right, act, authorization, or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or the prime contract Contracting Officer or the contracting officer's duly authorized representative; (3) when access to proprietary financial information or other proprietary data is required; (4) when title to property is to be transferred directly to the Government; (5) in patent rights clauses, if any; and (6) where specifically modified as noted below. For the purposes of the provisions below, a "Commercial Items Order" is one in which all of the Products are "commercial products" and all of the Services are "commercial services" as defined in FAR 2.101; i.e., the Purchase Order includes only commercial items and no non-commercial items. "Purchase Order Price" price means the total price for all line items on the Purchase Order.

Some of the clauses listed below include information about the circumstances under which they are applicable. If the conditions for applicability provided in parentheses after any such clauses are not met (considering the nature and amount of the Purchase Order and the status of Seller), that clause does not apply to and is not included in that Purchase Order.

- 52.203-7 Anti-Kickback Procedures (JUN 2020) (applies if the Purchase Order is not a Commercial Items Order and the Purchase Order Price exceeds \$250,000)
- 52.203-13 Contractor Code of Business Ethics and Conduct (JUN 2020) (applies if the Purchase Order Price exceeds \$5,500,000 and the Ship By Date for any line item is more than 120 days from the date of the Purchase Order)

- 52.203-17 Contractor Employee Whistleblower Rights and Requirement to Inform Employees of Whistleblower Rights (JUN 2020) (applies if the Purchase Order is not a Commercial Items Order)
- DOJ-01 Whistleblower Information Distribution (Oct 2021) (applies if the Customer is or is a part of the United States Department of Justice. Seller must provide to each of its employees, within 20 days of accepting the Purchase Order, the document located at <u>https://oig.justice.gov/sites/default/files/2020-04/NDAA-brochure.pdf</u>. Seller must report compliance to the ADS Purchasing Rep within 30 days of accepting the Purchase Order).
- 52.203-19 Prohibition on Requiring Certain Internal Confidentiality Agreements or Statements (JAN 2017)
- 52.204-2 Security Requirements (MAR 2021) (excluding the references in Paragraphs (c) and (d) to the "Changes clause of this contract") (applies if the Purchase Order involves access by Seller to information classified as "Confidential", "Secret", or "Top Secret" by the Government)
- 52.204-9 Personal Identity Verification of Contractor Personnel (JAN 2011) (applies if the Services involve routine physical access to a Federally controlled facility)
- 52.204-10 Reporting Executive Compensation and First-Tier Subcontract Awards (JUN 2020) (applies only to the extent that ADS is required to provide information on Seller's executive compensation under 52.204-10(d)(3), and requires only that Seller provide such information to ADS promptly on request))
- 52.204-14 Service Contract Reporting Requirements (OCT 2016) (applies if the Purchase Order is not a Commercial Item Order, the Purchase Order Price exceeds \$500,000, and the Purchase Order includes Services, but requires only that the Seller provide to ADS the information required under Subparagraph (f)(1) promptly on ADS's request)
- 52.204-15 Service Contract Reporting Requirements for Indefinite-Delivery Contracts (OCT 2016) (applies if the Purchase Order is not a Commercial Item Order, the Purchase Order Price exceeds \$500,000, and the Purchase Order includes Services, but requires only that the Seller provide to ADS the information required under Subparagraph (f)(1) promptly on ADS's request)
- 52.204-18 Commercial and Government Entity Code Maintenance (AUG 2020) (applies if FAR 52.204-2 applies to the Purchase Order)



- 52.204-21 Basic Safeguarding of Covered Contractor Information Systems (JUN 2016) (applies if Seller has or will have Federal contract information in or transiting through its information system(s))
- 52.204-23 Prohibition on Contracting for Hardware, Software, and Services Developed or Provided by Kaspersky Lab and Other Covered Entities (JUL 2018)
- 52.204-25 Prohibition on Contracting for Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment (AUG 2020) (excluding paragraph 52.204-25(b)(2))
- 52.204-27 Prohibition on a ByteDance Covered Application (JUN 2023)
- 52.209-6 Protecting the Government's Interest When Subcontracting with Contractors Debarred, Suspended, or Proposed for Debarment (JUN 2020) (applies if Purchase Order Price exceeds \$35,000 and the Purchase Order includes any Services or Products that are not COTS items (as defined at FAR 2.101))
- 52.211-5 Material Requirements (AUG 2000) (applies if the Purchase Order is not a Commercial Item Order)
- 52.211-15 Defense Priority and Allocation Requirements (APR 2008) (applies if the Purchase Order states that it is a rated order and provides the DPAS rating)
- 52.215-14 Integrity of Unit Prices (JUN 2020) (applies to Purchase Orders that include Products, have a total price of \$250,000 or more, and are not Commercial Items Orders)
- 52.219-8 Utilization of Small Business Concerns (OCT 2018)
- 52.222-21 Prohibition of Segregated Facilities (APR 2015)
- 52.222-26 Equal Opportunity (SEP 2016)
- 52.222-35 Equal Opportunity for Veterans (JUN 2020)
- 52.222-36 Equal Opportunity for Workers with Disabilities (JUN 2020) (applies if the Purchase Order Price exceeds \$15,000; paragraph (b)(2) is revised to delete "and provided by or through the Contracting Officer" and insert "and provided upon request by the Contracting Officer through the Buyer.")
- 52.222-37 Employment Reports on Veterans (JUN 2020)
- 52.222-40 Notification of Employee Rights Under the National Labor Relations Act (DEC 2010)
- 52.222-50 Combating Trafficking in Persons (OCT 2020)
